Introducing ESI Mobile Messaging

Now you can receive an email notification whenever you receive a voice message on your ESI phone system. You can also choose to have a .WAV file attached so you can play your messages anywhere you have access to your email account, you can even share voicemails with others, even if they do not have an ESI system.



By displaying the Caller ID name and number, date, time, and duration, mobile messaging also enables you to manage your messages by choosing which to play and which to save for later. Mobile Messaging is the first of many exciting features now available on the ESI 50,100, 200, 600 and 1000 systems.
